

Guidelines and Criteria for Washington State Non-Nurse School Nurse Administrator of the Year Award

Purpose:

To publicly recognize a non-nurse school nurse administrator by annually honoring one administrator who coordinates and advocates for quality school nursing services and health programs.

Eligibility:

- 1. One (1) nominee from each area
- 2. Nominee must be:
 - a. Bachelor degree or higher
 - b. Member of SNOW recommended
- 3. Nominee must have as their responsibility the supervision, administration and coordination of nursing services and health programs, and be a strong school nurse advocate

Procedure for Submission of Application:

- 1. Nominations should include:
 - a. Completed nomination form
 - b. Up to two supporting letters of recommendation (*letters may be provided by nurses, principals, teachers, community members, or anyone familiar with the nominee's impact*):
 - i. Letters should describe specific issues or topics related to the nominee's qualifications for the award and overall impact.
 - ii. Letters should directly reflect areas of rating that writer wishes to emphasize
 - iii. Local and State acronyms must be spelled out when used for the first time.
 - c. Completed nomination packet and supporting documents must be submitted electronically to the Awards Chair listed on the SNOW webpage under Awards by April 1st.

Criteria for Selection:

- 1. Demonstrates leadership toward improving the health and educational success of children in the state of Washington.
- 2. Demonstrates a commitment to advancing the practice of school nursing in Washington State.
- 3. Demonstrates an understanding of the importance of school nurses as the leading experts regarding school health issues.
